WHY OUR PROGRAM'S A FIT FOR YOU!

Develops the Fundamentals for Life

Dignity, Respect & Inclusion: Our program aims to develop “all-round” citizenship. Respect for every person’s dignity underscores learning about respect for self and others, and furthers the welcoming of difference, diversity and multiculturalism. We work on the skills young people need to be assertive, have good interpersonal relationships, resolve conflicts, be inclusive, and live harmoniously with others.

Human Rights: Our program helps youth and children to learn about human rights and how to put them into action at home, at school, at work and in the community. They leave knowing how to recognize the roots of oppressive practices such as bullying and other such human rights violations, and to tackle them in comprehensive and cohesive ways.

Critical Thinking: Through a variety of fun and engaging age-appropriate activities, trained *BIAS FREE* staff guide youth and children to better analyze and understand the world around them and to build the skills, knowledge and capacity to co-create positive and peaceful situations in which diversity can thrive. Our program emphasizes critical thinking, effective communication, and effective decision-making skills that participants need for success in school, at work and in life.

Improves Self Confidence

Self-esteem: Our program gives youth and children the confidence they need to challenge themselves, enhancing self-awareness and self-esteem.

Participatory Learning: We use a participatory learning model, with an emphasis on having fun while learning.

Our Level II LIT Program prepares youth for jobs in the community. *BIAS FREE* Co-op is interested in providing opportunities for further training and work with us to youth who are interested and demonstrate sufficient knowledge and expertise.
